Haiti Weather Hazards Assessment

For
August 4 - 10, 2005

1. Drier than normal conditions over the past 2 to 4 weeks may reduce topsoil moisture for the planting of sorghum, second season rice and second season beans over southwestern Haiti. The dryness has likely had minimal negative impact on first season crops and has probably favored fieldwork. Scattered showers are possible during the period.
