

Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

For September 28 – October 4. 2006

Hispaniola's first season was near normal. Although some areas did experience occasional dry spells crop production was not impacted on a regional scale. Local areas, such as North-west may have experienced more significant problems. The second season has so far been off to a good start with well distributed rains. Most areas since August have received more than 100 mm of precipitation.
