

## The USAID FEWS-NET Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

October 25 - 31, 2006

Rainfall so far for the month of October has been abundant across much of the island. This favored sorghum and second season rice, but may have slowed second season bean harvesting activities in some areas. Conditions have been dry across southern portions of the island, reducing moisture for local crops, pastures and water supplies. Over the next week, showers are expected across the island. The highest amounts of rainfall are expected across the northern portions of the island.
