### Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

April 12 –18, 2007

Early season rains have provided favorable soil conditions across much of Hispaniola. Some locations have seen flooding, primary along the northern coast of Haiti, near Port-au-Prince and along the southwestern peninsula. During the last week there has been less precipitation, allowing those areas that experienced flooding a chance to dry out. Scattered showers are likely across the island during the coming week.
