

## **Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment**

For **September 13 – 19, 2007** 



Rainfall continues to favor second season crops across Hispaniola. This comes immediately following the good first season rainfall earlier this year. Moisture has been evenly distributed and sufficient for crops across the island. Only occasionally has precipitation become excessive causing localized flooding.
