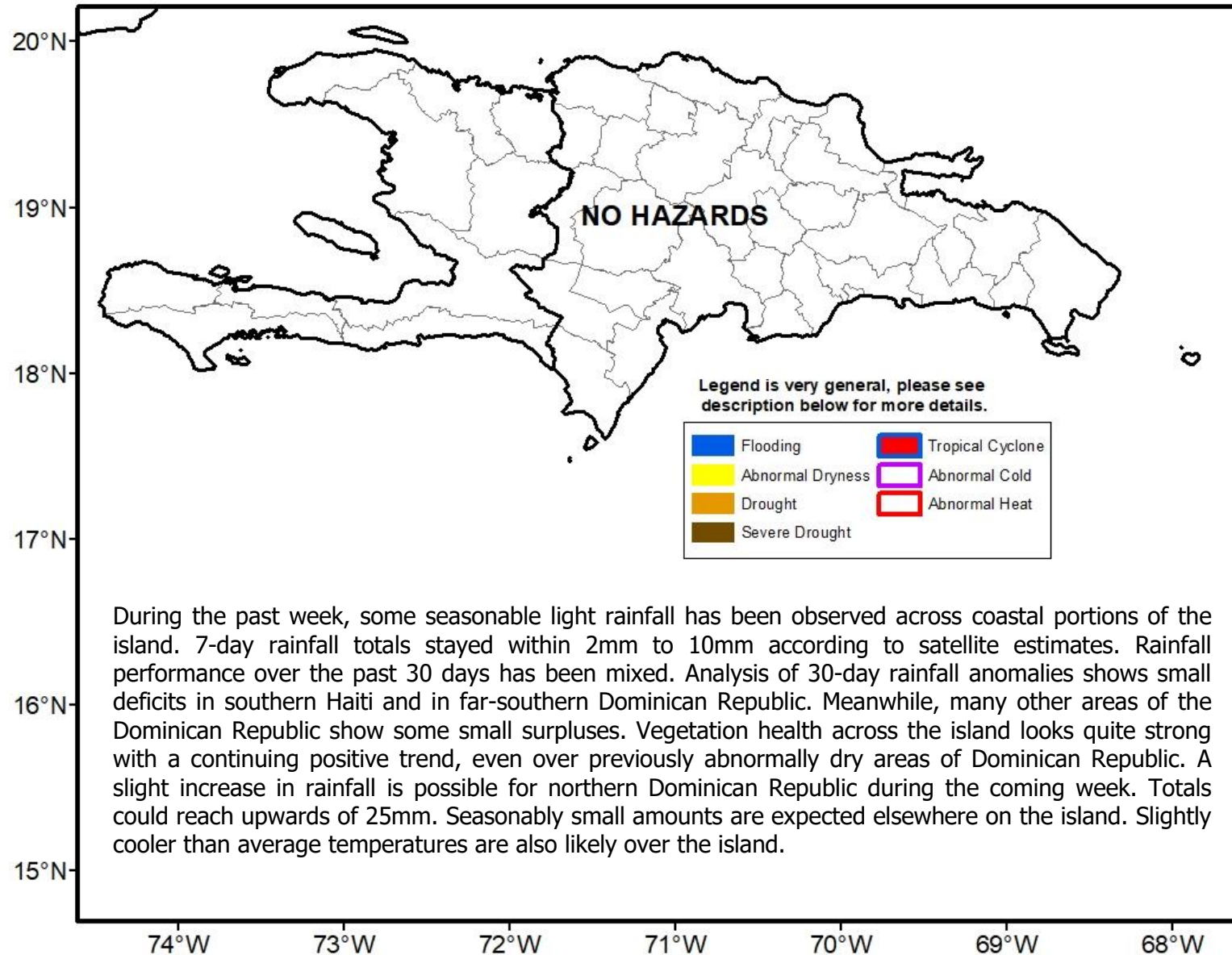




Climate Prediction Center's Hispaniola Hazards Outlook January 9 – January 15, 2020

- Seasonable light rainfall has been recorded over Hispaniola this past week



During the past week, some seasonable light rainfall has been observed across coastal portions of the island. 7-day rainfall totals stayed within 2mm to 10mm according to satellite estimates. Rainfall performance over the past 30 days has been mixed. Analysis of 30-day rainfall anomalies shows small deficits in southern Haiti and in far-southern Dominican Republic. Meanwhile, many other areas of the Dominican Republic show some small surpluses. Vegetation health across the island looks quite strong with a continuing positive trend, even over previously abnormally dry areas of Dominican Republic. A slight increase in rainfall is possible for northern Dominican Republic during the coming week. Totals could reach upwards of 25mm. Seasonably small amounts are expected elsewhere on the island. Slightly cooler than average temperatures are also likely over the island.
