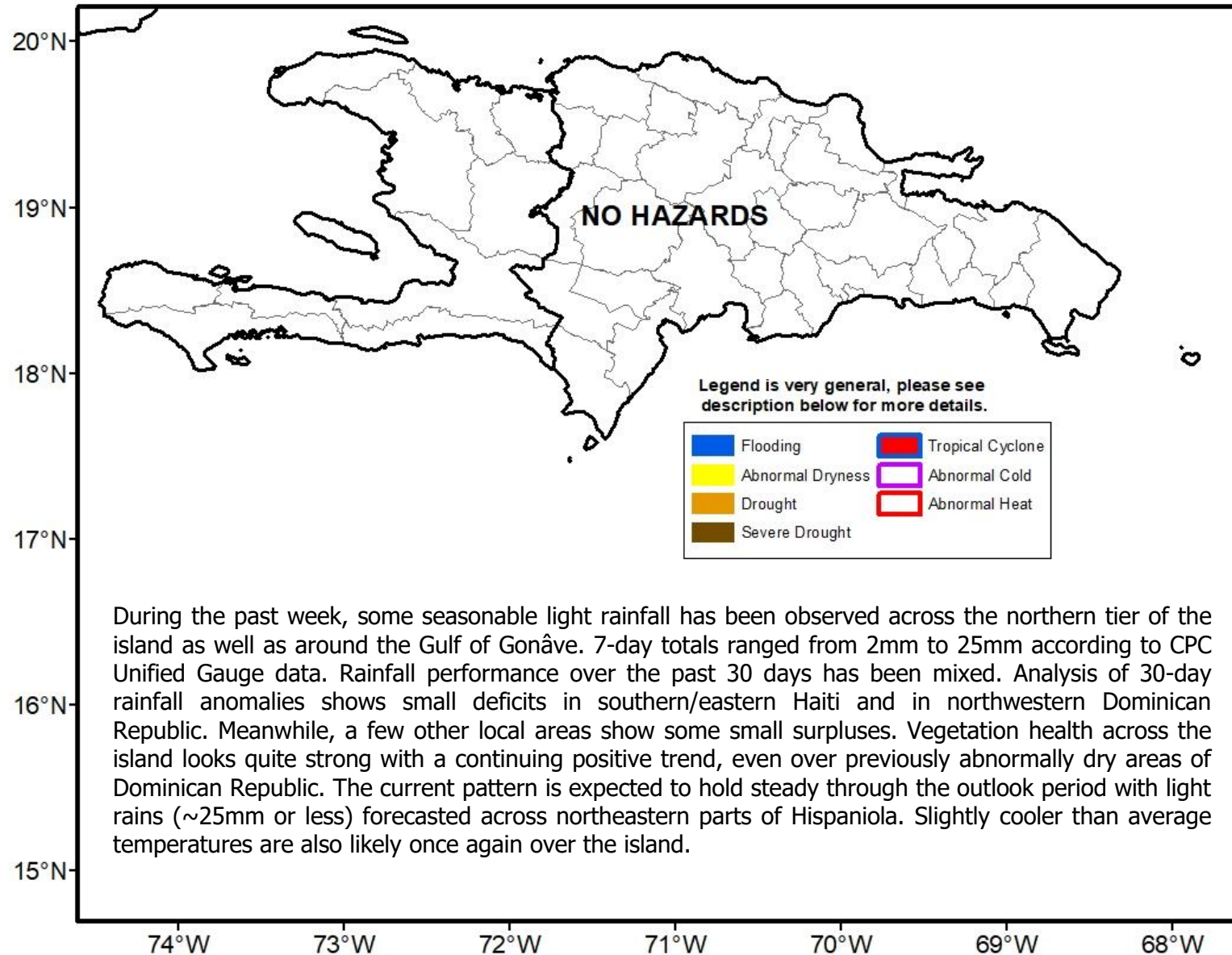




## Climate Prediction Center's Hispaniola Hazards Outlook January 16 – January 22, 2020

- Seasonable light rainfall has been recorded over Hispaniola this past week



During the past week, some seasonable light rainfall has been observed across the northern tier of the island as well as around the Gulf of Gonâve. 7-day totals ranged from 2mm to 25mm according to CPC Unified Gauge data. Rainfall performance over the past 30 days has been mixed. Analysis of 30-day rainfall anomalies shows small deficits in southern/eastern Haiti and in northwestern Dominican Republic. Meanwhile, a few other local areas show some small surpluses. Vegetation health across the island looks quite strong with a continuing positive trend, even over previously abnormally dry areas of Dominican Republic. The current pattern is expected to hold steady through the outlook period with light rains (~25mm or less) forecasted across northeastern parts of Hispaniola. Slightly cooler than average temperatures are also likely once again over the island.
