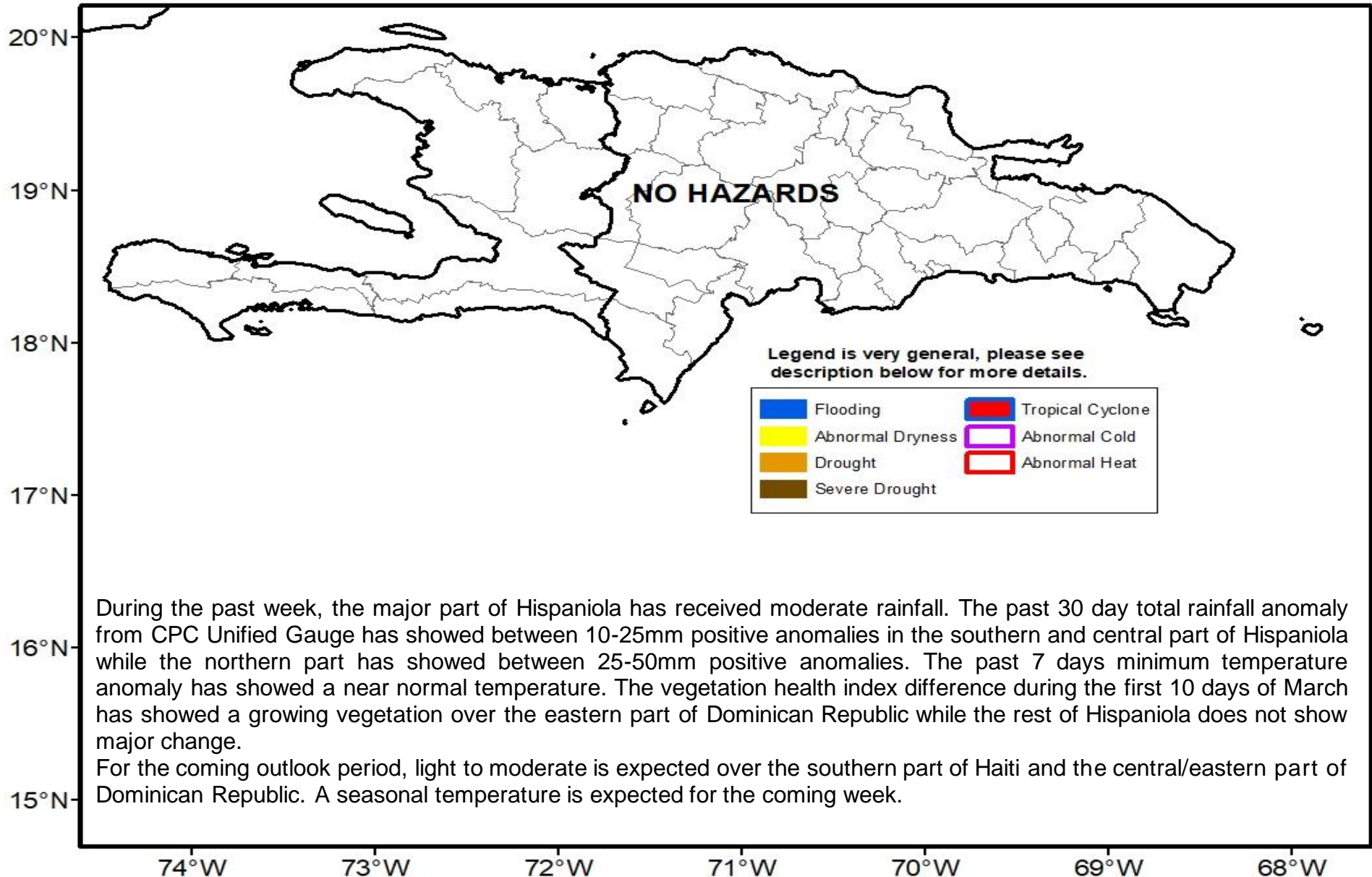




Climate Prediction Center's Hispaniola Hazards Outlook March 19 – 25, 2020

Light to moderate rainfall has been registered overall Hispaniola



During the past week, the major part of Hispaniola has received moderate rainfall. The past 30 day total rainfall anomaly from CPC Unified Gauge has showed between 10-25mm positive anomalies in the southern and central part of Hispaniola while the northern part has showed between 25-50mm positive anomalies. The past 7 days minimum temperature anomaly has showed a near normal temperature. The vegetation health index difference during the first 10 days of March has showed a growing vegetation over the eastern part of Dominican Republic while the rest of Hispaniola does not show major change.

For the coming outlook period, light to moderate is expected over the southern part of Haiti and the central/eastern part of Dominican Republic. A seasonal temperature is expected for the coming week.
