

CPC Africa Desk InterTropical (ITF) Front Analysis



Discussion:


From April 21-30, the Inter-Tropical Front (ITF) advanced northward relative to its previous position. The western (10W-10E) portion of the ITF was located approximately at 13.2N, which coincided with the climatological position. Meanwhile, the eastern (20E-35E) portion of the ITF was approximated at 10.0N, which was above the long-term average position by 0.2 degree. Figure 1 displays the current position of the ITF relative to the climatological position during the 3rd dekad of April and its previous position during the 2nd dekad of April. Figures 2 and 3 are time series, illustrating the latitudinal positions for the western and eastern portion of the ITF, respectively, and their seasonal evolutions since the beginning of April 2024.
