# Haiti Weather Hazards Assessment

for

**September 30 – October 6, 2004**

1) Although Haiti's Northwest Department remained dry over the past week, the second growing season is off to an admirable start. Rains for August and September are about 100 mm above normal. This is especially true for eastern regions of the hazard area. Further west, rainfall totals are near normal. The forecast remains dry for the region over the next week.

2) The forecast remains mostly dry for the week over areas where significant flooding has occurred. This should help with the damage assessment and clean up efforts
