Haiti Weather Hazards Assessment

for **June 2 - 8, 2005**

Drought conditions since November 2004 resulted in below normal harvests last season across Centre and Artibonite Departments of Haiti, as well as the surrounding areas. Across southern Haiti, drought conditions led to below average harvests. However, the rains since April have been have been good and have greatly improved the drought conditions in most areas. The forecast calls for a continuation of occasional showers during the upcoming week.
