Haiti Weather Hazards Assessment

July 7 -13, 2005

1) Tropical Storm Dennis will bring heavy rains and strong winds to southern Haiti and southwestern parts of the Dominican Republic through the late morning hours on Thursday, July 7. The primary concern from Dennis is the heavy rains which may cause flooding, landslides and crop damage. Conditions are expected to improve late in the day on the 7th as Dennis moves off to the northwest towards Cuba. Please refer to the National Hurricane Center for the latest updates on Dennis.
