Haiti Weather Hazards Assessment

For

October 13 - 19, 2005

1) Heavy rain may trigger flooding, landslides and localized crop damage across Hispaniola (October 13 - 16). The heaviest rains are expected across Haiti and southwestern parts of the Dominican Republic. Additional rainfall, some of which may be locally heavy, is expected across the island throughout the period. Weekly rainfall totals are expected to range from 100 to 200 mm, with locally higher amounts in Haiti.
