Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

April 27 – May 3, 2006

Showers and thunderstorms during the beginning of April were followed by drier weather. Rains have recently increased across the region. These conditions favored land preparation and planting. During the period, showers and thunderstorms are expected to benefit recently sown crops, pastures and water supplies in the region. However, some localized flash flooding is possible across the interior.
