### Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

This past week northern areas of Hispaniola as well as extreme south-west Haiti received measurable rainfall amounts. The rain in south-west Haiti was very important in terms of crop production for the region. Though rain fell in some areas, parts of southern and extreme north-west Haiti continue to be of concern regarding below normal rainfall. May and June are the two key months for crop development so hopefully Hispaniola sees more beneficial rainfall over the next few weeks. This upcoming period scattered rainfall activity is forecasted for the region. Any rainfall will be beneficial for crop production that is currently taking place.
