

The USAID FEWS-NET Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

June 15 - 21, 2006

1) Moderate seasonal rains fell over northern Haiti, while rains were more scattered over the rest of Hispaniola. Over the northwestern parts of the country, seasonal rains have been lacking. Satellite imagery indicates stressed vegetation and field reports indicate that the lack of rainfall has resulted in some problems. Late planting and stressed crops constitute a major concern across the northwestern corner of Haiti. However, thundershowers may provide some relief during the period.
