

The USAID FEWS-NET Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

June 22 - 28, 2006

1) Moderate to locally heavy seasonal rains fell over much of Haiti and northern parts of the Dominican Republic, while rains were more scattered over southern and eastern Hispaniola. Over the northwestern parts of Haiti, seasonal rains have been lacking. Satellite imagery indicates stressed vegetation and field reports indicate that the lack of rainfall has resulted in some problems. Late planting and stressed crops constitute a major concern across the northwestern corner of Haiti. However, showers may provide some relief during the period.
