For **July 6 – 12, 2006**

1. Coastal Artibonite, and portions of the Northwest Department have experienced dryness during the past several months. This has led to stressed crops and will likely reduce crop yields in the area. Some light relief has fallen during the past week. However, this has not provided enough precipitation to significantly improve conditions in this region of the island. 0
