


The USAID FEWS-NET Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

November 2 - 8, 2006

Rainfall so far for the month of October has been abundant across much of the island. This favored sorghum and second season rice, while increasing moisture for thrid season beans. Over the past week, a frontal system produced significant rains across the island. Heavy rains fell across the northern tier of the island on the 26th and 27th, while locally heavy rains soaked the southern tier on the 29th. Scattered showers are expected across the island during the period, which should continue to favor crops and pastures.
