### Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

A near normal season on Hispaniola is coming to an end with above normal rainfall. After some crop damage during the last days of October, a strong front currently moving through the Caribbean will likely bring heavy rainfall to what are usually the more drought prone areas of the island. Rainfall could be heavy enough to cause minor flooding along both peninsulas during the early part of the period.
