Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

Rainfall has been plentiful across Hispaniola this year, but at times too much rainfall caused problems. Some crop damage during the last days of October, and a strong front that moved through the Caribbean last week brought heavy rainfall to what are usually the drought prone areas of the island. Last week's flooding caused significant damage to Haiti's northern and southern peninsulas. Calmer conditions will prevail next week.
