Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

April 19 –25, 2007

Rainfall during the current season has been well distributed and above normal across most of Hispanola. The precipitation has benefited crop conditions in the main production areas of the island. However, the above normal rainfall totals have caused some localized flooding, mainly along the northern coast of Haiti, near Port-au-Prince, and along the southwestern peninsula. There was very little precipitation during the past week, however rainfall is likely to return to the island next week.
