Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

April 26 – May 2, 2007

Although the season started off well over much of Hispaniola, rainfall has decreased during the past few weeks. Soil conditions remain good in the northern portions of the island (shown below), but further south and west early season rains have given way to dry conditions. If rain does not fall during the next week to two weeks short term dryness will begin to stress crops.
