Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

May 31 – June 6, 2007

During the last period the entire island experienced some degree of rainfall accumulation, with lower totals in the northwest peninsula. In Port au Prince, runoff water and minor flooding caused property loss and a few casualties. Despite negative soil water anomalies at the start of the season, the soil water index shows improvement across the entire island. Continuing rains are expected to bring more improvement to the west as well as concerns of flooding.
