

Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

April 17 – April 23, 2008



Rainfall has remained constant since the start of April, with daily rainfall ranging from 0 mm to 30 mm on average across Hispaniola. During the first dekad of April rainfall exceeded 150 mm for the north central mountainous area of Haiti, this has caused positive anomalies in that region while others remain below normal for the month. At present, the same area in Haiti is doing well in addition to western Dominican Republic for the Apante season. In the next 72 hours seasonal rains are expected in the north central area of the Dominican Republic while moderate rains are expected elsewhere.
