

Haiti Weather Hazards and Benefits Assessment

For **July 10 – July 16, 2008**



Precipitation totals remain above average for most of the island for the May – August season with the exception of the far western and eastern regions and the southern coastal peninsula of Haiti which is experiencing rainfall totals near 25% of average. However, since the start of July, rainfall accumulation has been decreasing, but poses no threat to current agricultural activity. During the last two observation periods maximum rainfall totals have been near 50 mm. During the July 10-16 observation period light rains can be expected across the island.
