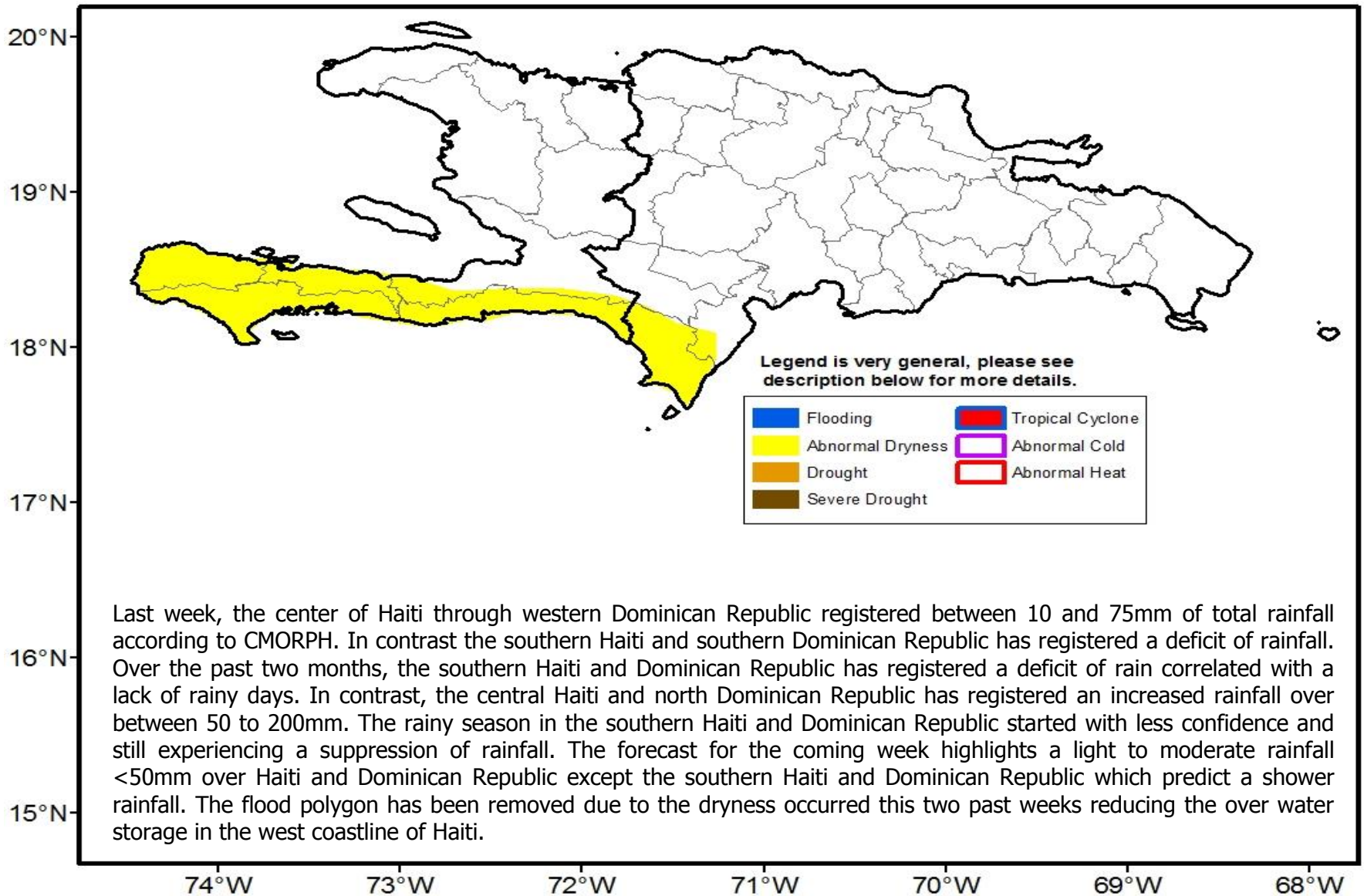




## Climate Prediction Center's Hispaniola Hazards Outlook June 27 – July 03, 2019

- Seasonably light rainfall was observed in several parts of Hispaniola.



Last week, the center of Haiti through western Dominican Republic registered between 10 and 75mm of total rainfall according to CMORPH. In contrast the southern Haiti and southern Dominican Republic has registered a deficit of rainfall. Over the past two months, the southern Haiti and Dominican Republic has registered a deficit of rain correlated with a lack of rainy days. In contrast, the central Haiti and north Dominican Republic has registered an increased rainfall over between 50 to 200mm. The rainy season in the southern Haiti and Dominican Republic started with less confidence and still experiencing a suppression of rainfall. The forecast for the coming week highlights a light to moderate rainfall <50mm over Haiti and Dominican Republic except the southern Haiti and Dominican Republic which predict a shower rainfall. The flood polygon has been removed due to the dryness occurred this two past weeks reducing the over water storage in the west coastline of Haiti.
