



CPC Africa Desk InterTropical (ITF) Front Analysis

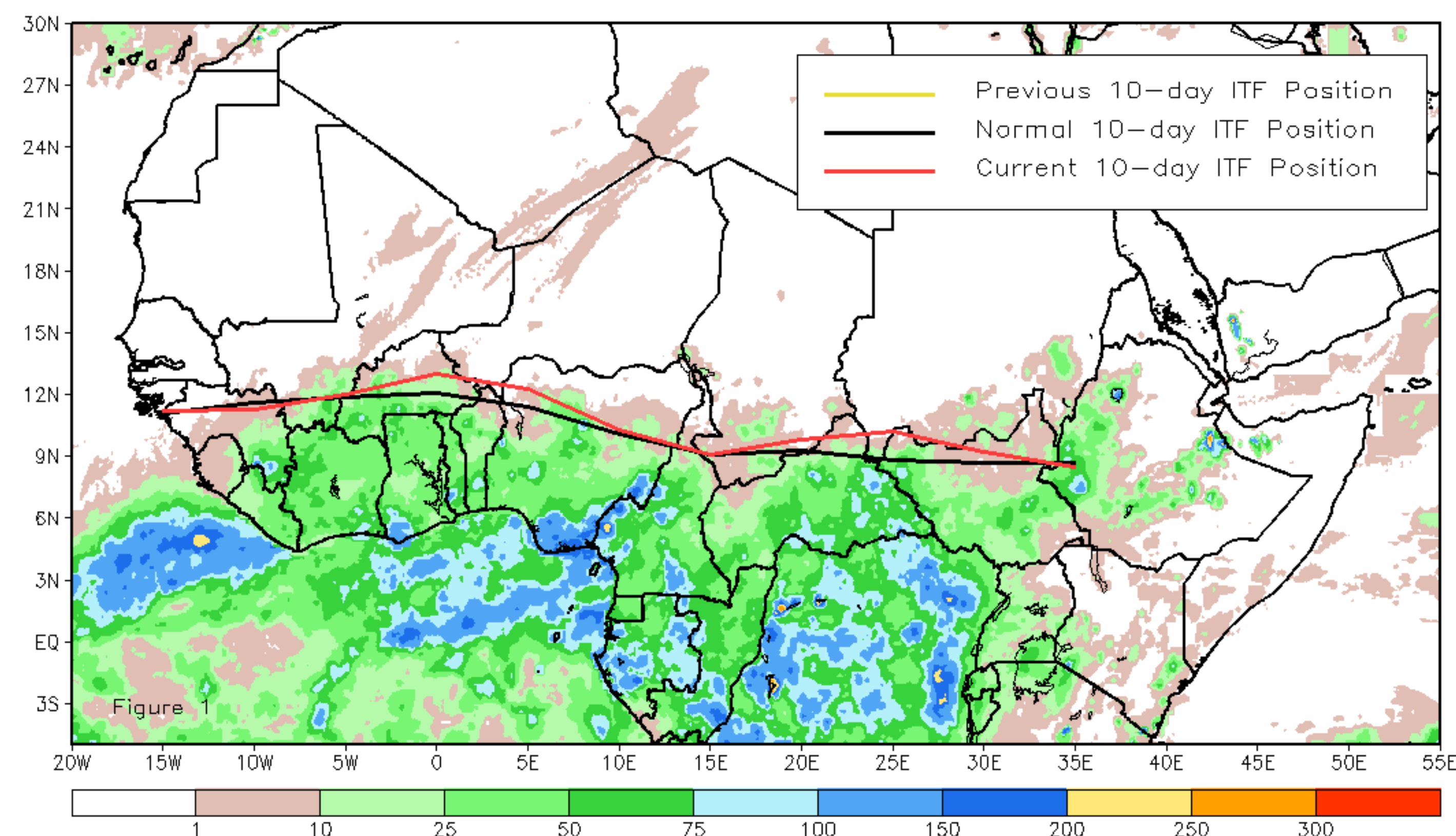

Discussion:

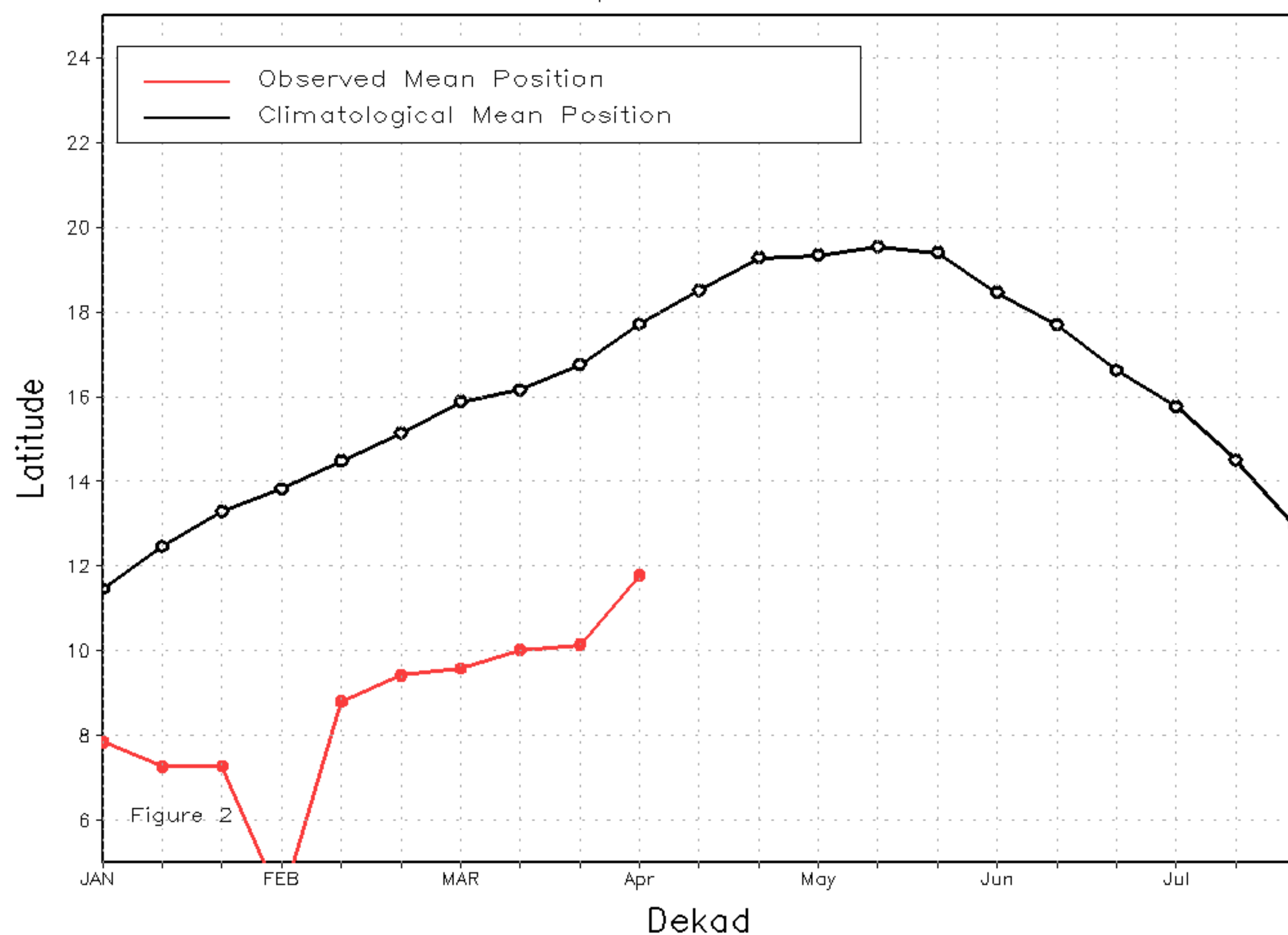
From 1-10 April, the ITF moved north relative to the normal position, which resulted in an overall anomalous northerly position, except along the western side. The western (10W-10E) portion of the ITF was located approximately at 11.8N, which is above the climatology position by 0.4 degree. The eastern (20E-35E) portion of the ITF was approximated at 9.4N, which is above the climatological position by 0.5 degree. Figure 1 displays the current position of the ITF relative to the long-term average position during the 1st dekad of April. Figures 2 and 3 are time series, illustrating the latitudinal values of the western and eastern portions of the ITF, respectively, and their seasonal evolutions since the beginning of April, 2022.
