

CPC Africa Desk InterTropical (ITF) Front Analysis



Discussion:


Between February 11 and 20, the current Inter-Tropical Front (ITF) moved northward compared to its previous location. Specifically, the current ITF was located at approximately 9.1N in the western portion (10W-10E), which is north of its previous position at 7.7N. In the eastern part (20E-35E), the current ITF location is around 4.6N compared to 3.9N in the previous position. Figure 1 displays the current position of the ITF during the 2nd dekad of February and its previous position during the 1st dekad of February. Figures 2 and 3 are time series, illustrating the latitudinal positions for the western and eastern portions of the ITF, respectively, and their seasonal evolutions since the beginning of April 2025.
