



# CPC Africa Desk InterTropical (ITF) Front Analysis

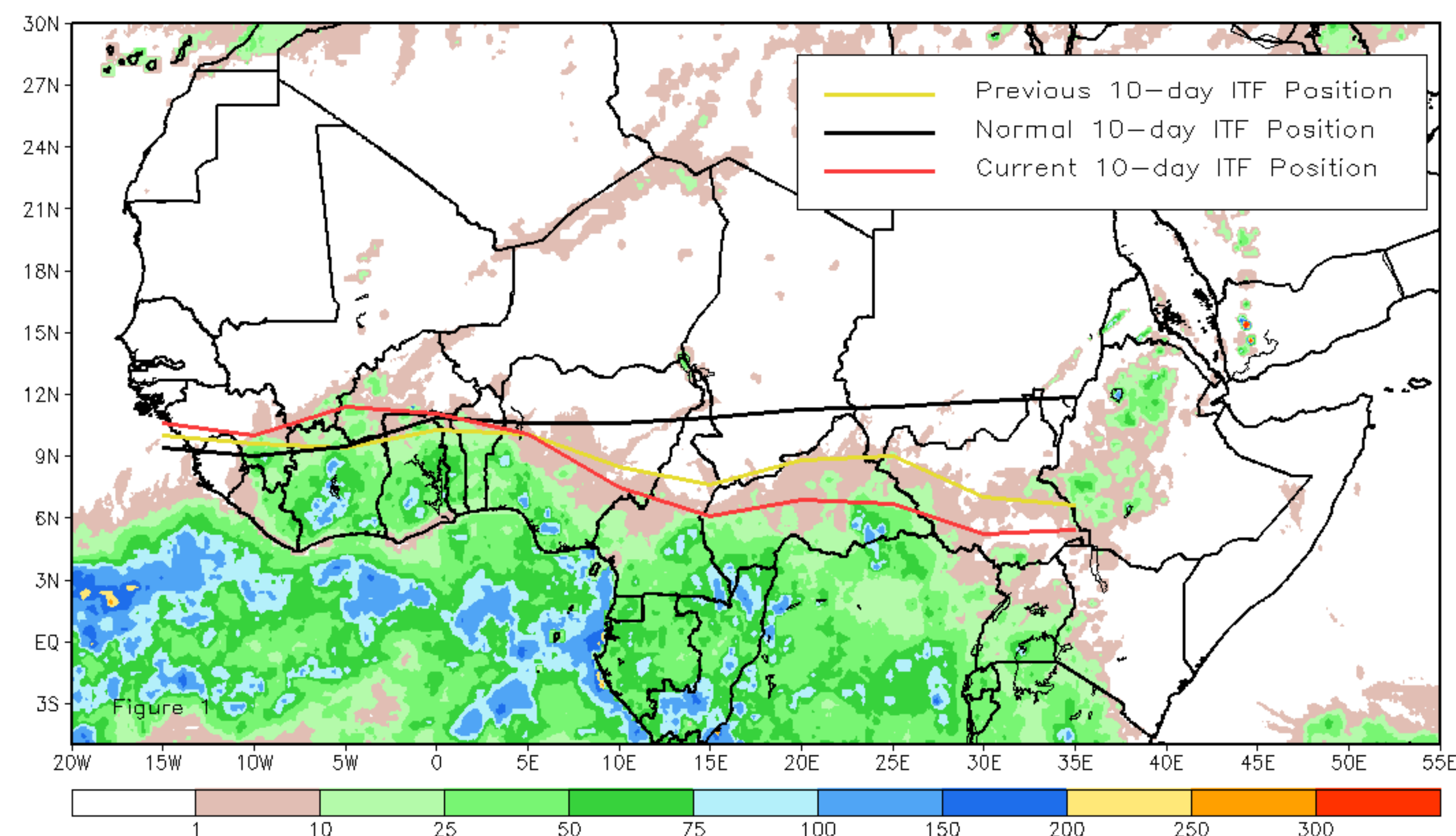
## March 2022, Dekad 2

### Discussion:

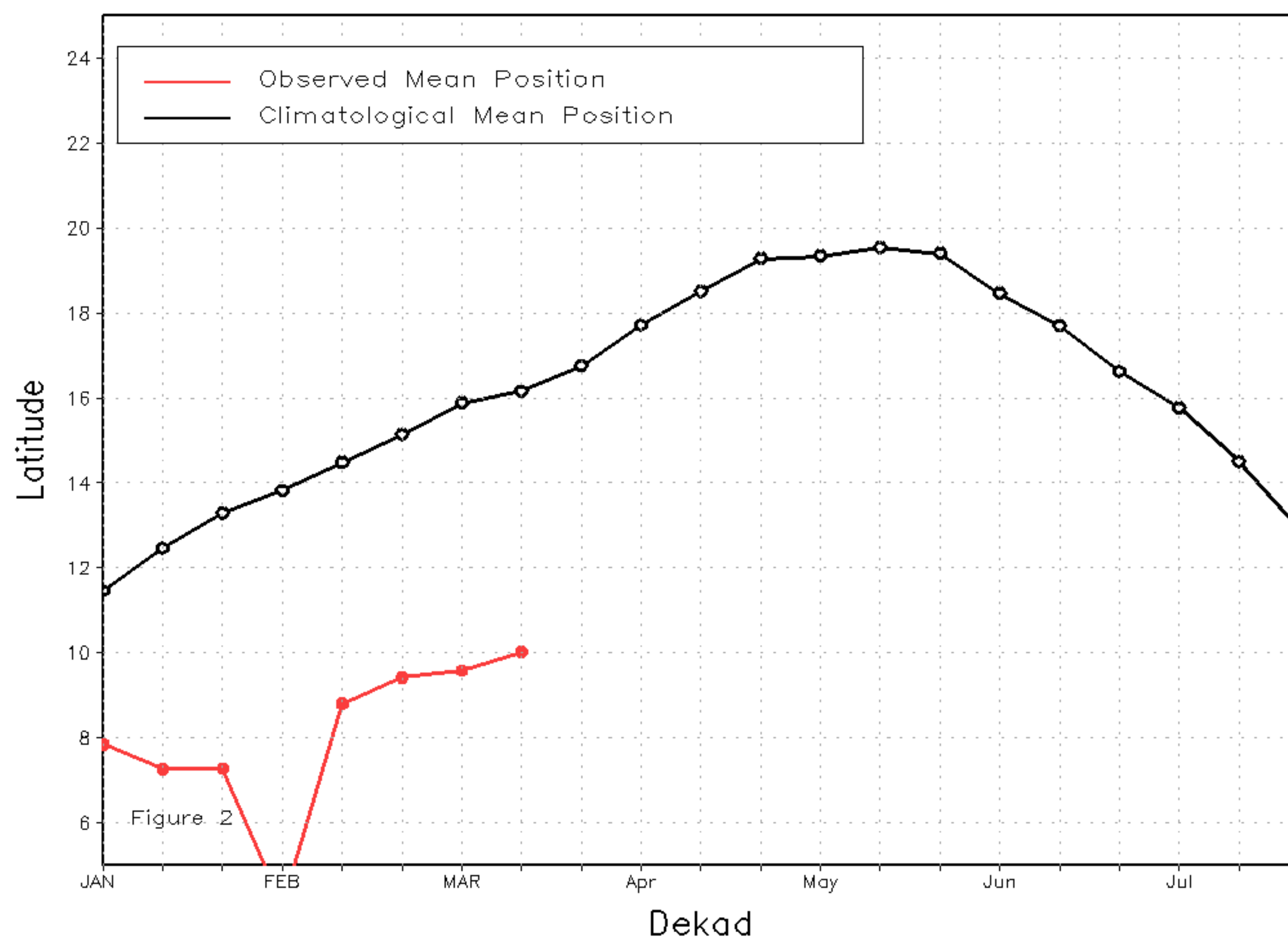
From 11-20 March, the ITF moved further south relative to its previous position, which resulted in an overall anomalous southerly position, except along its western edge (15W-5E). The western (10W-10E) portion of the ITF was located approximately at 10.0N, which is below the climatology position by 0.1 degree. The eastern (20E-35E) portion of the ITF was approximated at 6.1N, which is below the climatological position by 5.5 degree. Figure 1 displays the current position of the ITF relative to the long-term average position during the 1st dekad of March and its previous position during the 3rd dekad of February. Figures 2 and 3 are time series, illustrating the latitudinal values of the western and eastern portions of the ITF, respectively, and their seasonal evolutions since the beginning of January, 2022.
