



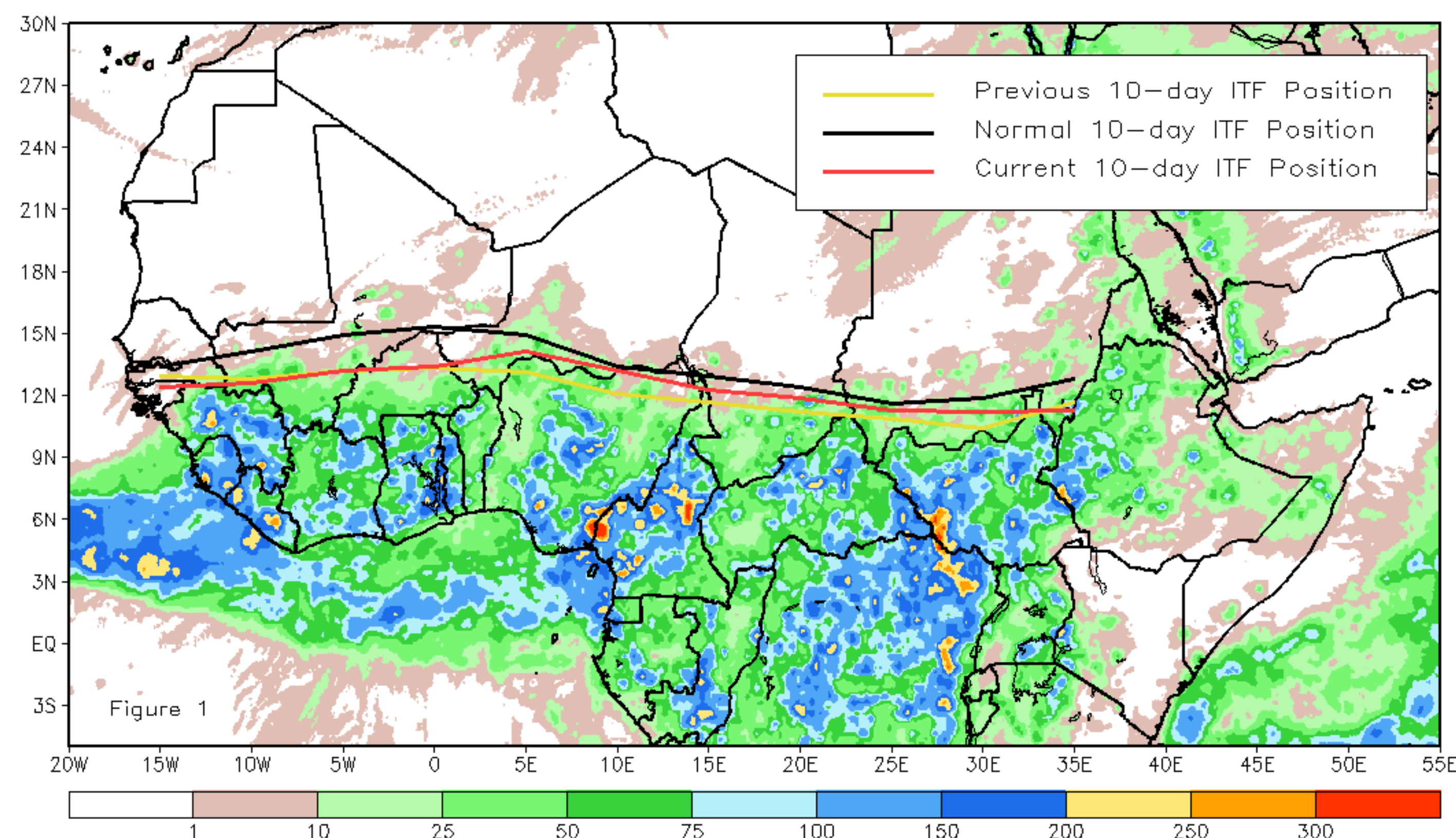
CPC Africa Desk InterTropical (ITF) Front Analysis

May 2020, Dekad 2

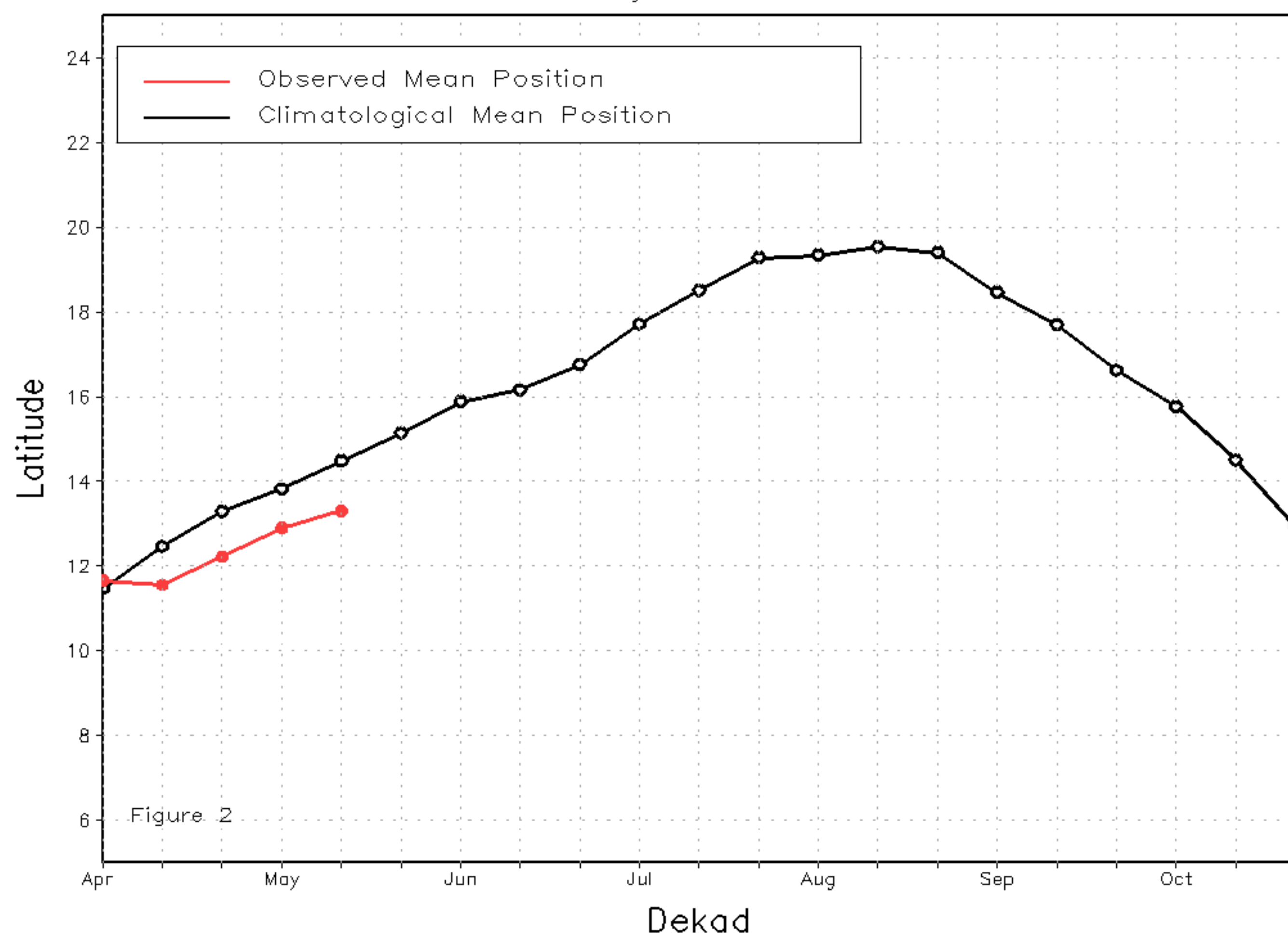
Discussion:

From May 11-20, the ITF has maintained a smooth movement slightly northward. The ITF position has remained below the long-term average position during this time of the year. The mean western (10W-10E) portion of the ITF was approximated at 13.3N, which is about 1.2 degree south of the normal. The mean eastern (20E-35E) portion of the ITF was located at 11.4N, which is 1.2 degree from the long-term mean position. Figure 1 displays the current position of the ITF relative to the long-term climatological position during the 1st dekad of May and its previous position during the 1 dekad of May. Figures 2 and 3 are time series, illustrating the latitudinal values of the western and eastern portions of the ITF, respectively, and their seasonal evolutions since April, 2020.
